If your client will use assets that are not cash, please state the nature of the assets, e.g. securities, bonds, etc., and if they can be converted into cash on demand. If your bank policies prevent the disclosure of account balances to third parties, then it will suffice if you state that your client has sufficient funds to finance their first year of study.
