

OFFICE OF WORK/LIFE

Harvard offers child care scholarships, based on need, to eligible faculty, staff and postdocs that help defray the cost of child care. Scholarship awards vary from family to family and year to year, and payments are made on a reimbursement basis.

DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCEMENT DESIGN DISCOVERY:

After 40+ years, Career Discovery changed its name. Now called Design Discovery: Harvard GSD, the name reflects the evolution of the program. Once a career exploratory program, Design Discovery helps students learn about the design disciplines and the skills and mental health habits needed to pursue a degree in this area. Studios are led by recent graduates or advance GSD students who are mentored by current GSD faculty and a faculty director. 243 students are currently enrolled, the 2nd largest number in the history of the program. The student body represents a diverse population that have traveled from 16 countries and 37 U.S. states. We hope this year's group of students experience the best of what the GSD offers and allows them to find a passion they can pursue.

We are also proud to announce the renaming of Project Link to Design Discovery YA; a program similar to Design Discovery for rising High School Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors from the Boston/Cambridge area. The rebranding of this program allows us to take advantage of the resources of Design Discovery and introduce the discipline of Design to younger minds. This year there are twelve students enrolled and we are looking forward to increased enrollment in the near future.
